

Lincoln Road

A simple lace shawl.

Designed for
handspun.

July 2015



The Verbiage:

k - knit

k2tog – knit 2 stitches together

yo – yarn over

slp – slip purl wise, with yarn to back

k3togtbl – knit 3 stitches together
through back loop.

T&W – turn work, with yarn in back,
slip the last unworked stitch onto the
left needle, bring yarn to the front,
slip the stitch back to the right needle
and bring the yarn to the back.



Yarns to Needles

Suggested yarn size to needles:

Lace Weight use US 2-7 (3-4.5 mm) 32” circular needle

Fingering Weight Use US 7-9 (4.5-6mm) 32” circular needle

DK/Worsted Weight Use US 10-11 (6-8 mm) 32” circular needle

Gauge: 3 sts/inch

Size: Approx. 8” middle, 6” ends, 48” long

This pattern was written for approximately 100 grams of DK/Worsted
Weight handspun.

The Lace & Fingering Weights have been included for yarn to needle size
though no alterations have been made to the pattern for the small
diameter yarns.

Let's Knit Lace!

Section A: Lace Edging

Cast on 9 sts.

Lace Rows:

Row 1: k1, yo, k1, [yo, ssk], twice, k3

Row 2 & all even rows through row 10: slp, k to end of row

Row 3: k1, yo, k3, [yo, ssk], twice, k2

Row 5: k1, yo, k5, [yo, ssk], twice, k1

Row 7: ssk, yo, ssk, k1, [k2tog, yo], twice, k3

Row 9: ssk, yo, k3togtbl, yo, k2tog, yo, k4

Row 11: ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k5

Row 12: slp, k to end of row.

Repeat the 12 lace rows a total of 20 times.

Bind off after the last row worked, leaving the last loop on the needle.

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Section B: Shawl Body

Knit up 119 sts (+the last loop from the bind off) along the top edge of the lace. (120 sts total)

Rows 1 – 3: Knit

Section D: Short Rows

Rows 1 & 2: Knit to 6 sts before end, T&W

Rows 3 & 4: Knit to 11 sts before end, T&W

Rows 5 & 6: Knit to 16 sts before end, T&W

Rows 7 & 8: Knit to 21 sts before end, T&W

Rows 9 & 10: Knit to 26 sts before end, T&W

Rows 11 & 12: Knit to 31 sts before end, T&W

Rows 13 & 14: Knit to 36 sts before end, T&W

Rows 15 & 16: Knit to 41 sts before end, T&W

Rows 17 & 18: Knit to 46 sts before end, T&W

Rows 19 & 20: Knit to 51 sts before end, T&W

Section C: The Steek

Row 1: k1, [k2tog, yo] repeat to last st, k1.

Row 2: k1, [k2tog, yo] repeat to last st, k1.

Rows 3 & 4: Knit

Section E: The Ending

Row 1: Knit to end of row, picking up wraps as you go.

Row 2: Knit row, picking up last half of wraps as you go.

Row 3: Knit row

Row 4: [k 8, k2tog], repeat to end

Row 5 & 6: knit

Bind Off.

Soak, block & wear!
